Established in 1961, Narrandera East is a specialist Infants School offering educational programs to children from five to eight years, in an excellent learning environment. It is the only separate Infants School in the Riverina and one of seventeen in the state.

Narrandera East Infants School is located next to the Showgrounds and within easy walking distance of both the High School and the Sports Stadium.

Our school is a modern co-educational public school with a long tradition of providing quality specialised education for students from Kindergarten to Year 2 in a stimulating and caring environment. It is widely regarded as a progressive country school with very nurturing and encouraging values.

Narrandera East Infants School Transition to School 2013

Our Transition to School Program will commence on Thursday, 19th July and will run for 12 weeks concluding on Thursday, 18th October. Each session will run from 9:00 am - 1.00 pm. Children need to bring a hat, drink and something for recess. Parents are not required to stay for the session but are most welcome to, if they wish.

The Transition Program is designed to help familiarize both you and your child with our school environment so that by February 2013 you will all be confident and happy at our school. The opportunity also enables new students and parents to develop positive relationships with members of the school community. Enrolment packages for 2013 can be collected from the office at any time.

Our transition Program is open to all four year old children who will be commencing Kindergarten in 2013 and may be considering Narrandera East.

Orientation Day

We will hold an Orientation Day on Thursday, 8th November from 9:00 am - 3:15 pm. This day is for those students who **will be enrolling at Narrandera East for 2013**.
