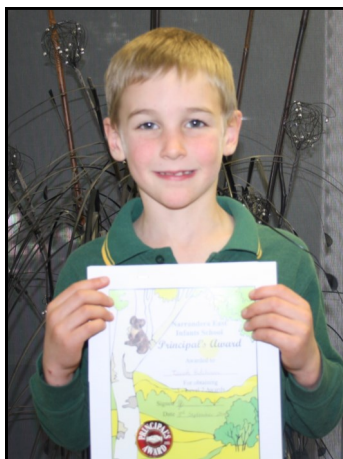
Year 2 Gala Cricket Day:
