

Online Payments

As from Monday the 26th October it will be possible for parents to make online payments to the school for amounts owing for students, via a secure payment page hosted by Westpac. Payments can be made using either a Visa or MasterCard credit or debit card. The payment page is accessed from the front page of the school's website by selecting \$ Make a payment

Items that can be paid include voluntary school backpack contributions, excursions, sales to students (not including uniform) and other school activities where a payment envelope is sent home from the school (these include gymnastics and footsteps dance etc). There is also a category called Other. This is to cover items not covered in the previous headings.

When you access the \$ Make a payment you **must** enter the following details:

- the students name,
- student's class and
- student's date of birth.

These details are entered each time you make a payment as student information is not held within the payment system. **There is also the option to enter the Student Registration Number and Invoice Number. These are not used at our school so please leave blank.**

If you are paying for more than one student you must make a separate payment for each. If you need to pay for more than one activity, they can be combined on one payment but NOT for more than one student. If you have two students at the school then two separate payments need to be processed.

A six digit number will come with the payment envelope sent home and this number should be used when processing the payment.

This is a secure payment system hosted by Westpac to ensure that your credit/debit card details are captured in a secure manner. **These details are not passed back to the school.**

You have the ability to check and change any details of the payment before the payment is processed. Receipts can be emailed to you and/or printed straight away. Please send that receipt number in to the school on the payment envelope you have received for the excursion or activity to let us know you have paid by direct deposit.

Details of the payments are passed daily to the school where they will be receipted against your child's account. Because a receipt is issued from the payment page a further receipt will not be issued by the school.

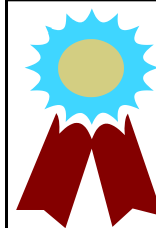

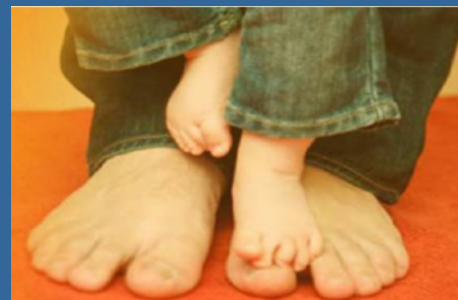
