## Head Lice Prevention Remedy

Into a 100ml spray bottle, add the following:

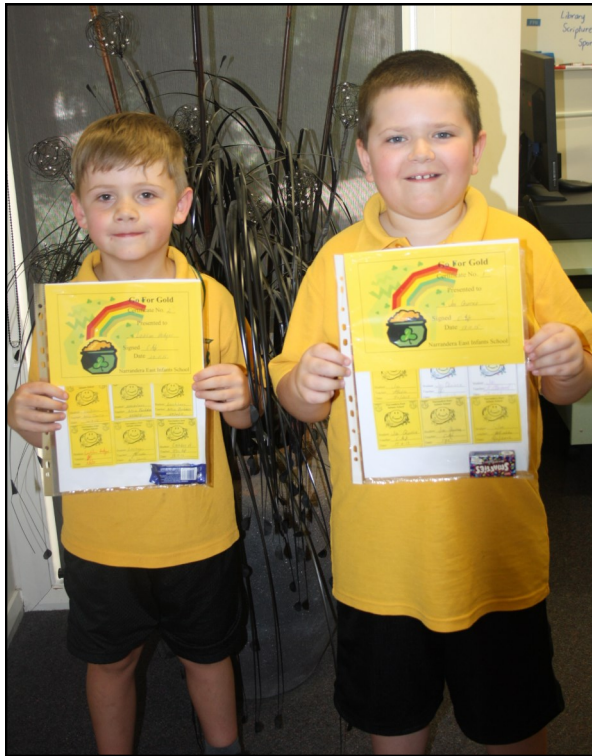
- 3 drops Tea Tree Pure Essential Oil
