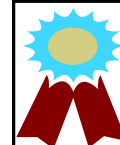

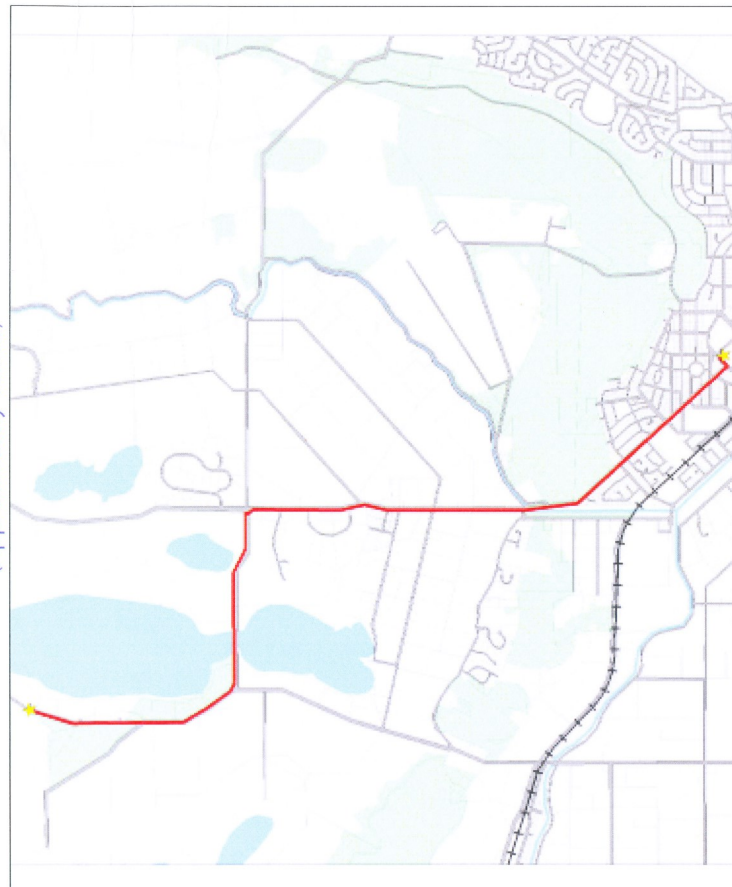
### Junior Tennis Coaching
