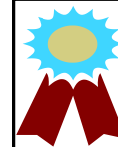
Fun Run Change of Date

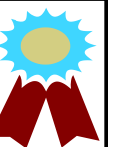

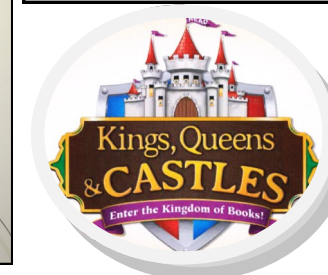
