This **Friday, 7th August**, borrowing will be done **first thing in the morning** (by 9.20am) before students catch the bus to Griffith.

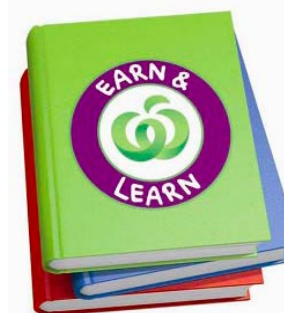
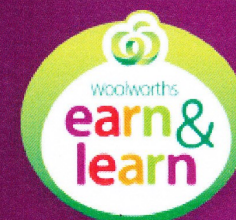

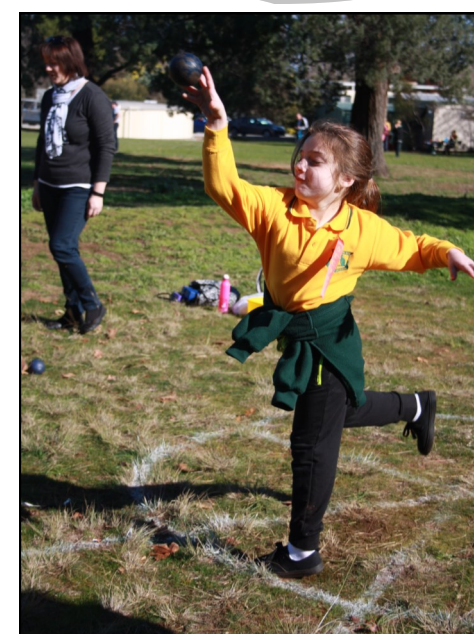
