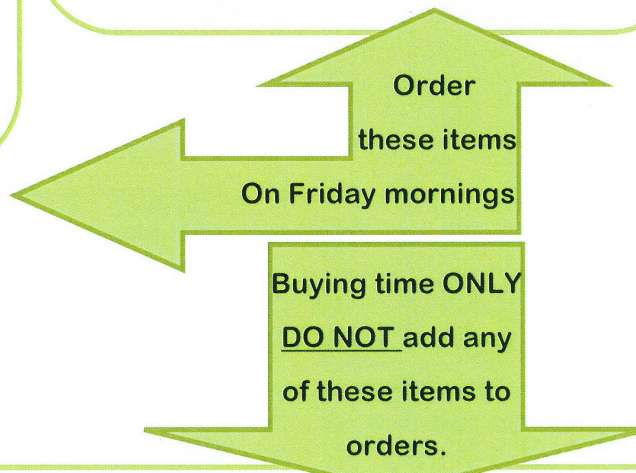

## TIPS FOR ADULTS AT KIDS SPORT

- Keep it fun** don't take it *too seriously* It's not the World Titles
- Be enthusiastic** but don't *scream & shout* instructions from the sideline
- Emphasise trying hard** *not winning*
- Cheer & acknowledge** good plays by *all players, both teams*
- Accept decisions** by officials they are human & *can make mistakes*
- Let **coaches do the coaching**
- Always remember, volunteers run kids sport**
- Understand, uphold and support** your club's **code of conduct**
- Allow your child to **play for themselves** Let kids make the decisions *on and off the field*
- Think before you speak** *Your words may harm others*
